Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the 2026-2027 school year! We hope you and your family have had a safe, relaxing, and enjoyable summer. As we prepare to welcome our students back to Evergreen Charter School, we would like to remind all families of our school uniform expectations to ensure every student begins the year ready for success.

Our uniform policy promotes a positive, respectful, and professional learning environment. We ask that all students arrive on the first day of school wearing the appropriate uniform.

Uniform Reminders

- **Boys wearing gray uniform pants must wear a black belt.**
- **Boys are required to wear a tie with the formal uniform:**
 - **5th Grade:** Green plaid tie
 - **6th Grade:** Gray tie
- **Only the white button-down collared shirt with the Evergreen school insignia may be worn with the formal uniform. Green polo shirts are not permitted as part of the formal uniform.**
- **Gym uniforms may only be worn on scheduled Physical Education days.**
- **The only sweatshirts permitted are the gray fleece and the green Evergreen crewneck sweatshirt on gym days.**

Additional reminders include:

- Girls should wear the approved white button-down shirt with the school insignia, charcoal gray pants, skirt, skort, or scooter, a black belt (if applicable), and closed-toe dress shoes.



- Boys should wear the approved white button-down shirt with the school insignia, charcoal gray pants or shorts, a black belt, black dress shoes, and the required grade-level tie.
- Shoes must be properly tied and appropriate for school. Open-toed shoes, sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, slides, high heels, and boots with excessive decorations are not permitted.
- Jewelry, outerwear, hats, and other accessories must comply with the school's dress code.

Uniform Expectations

To ensure consistency throughout the school year, the following procedures will be followed for uniform violations:

1. First offense: Parent/guardian will be contacted, and the proper uniform must be brought to school.
2. Second offense: Parent meeting, proper uniform must be brought to school, and detention will be assigned.
3. Third offense: One-day Out-of-School Suspension (OSS).
4. Fourth offense: Two-day Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) and a meeting with administration.

Uniform items may be purchased from any retailer as long as they meet Evergreen's color and style requirements. Families may also purchase approved items through local uniform retailers or the Evergreen Spirit Wear store.

We appreciate your partnership in helping us maintain the high standards that make Evergreen Charter School a positive and successful learning community. Ensuring that students arrive each day in the proper uniform allows us to focus on what matters most, our students learning. .
